Conventions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Writer uses vivid words and phrases that draw pictures in the reader's mind - Writer rarely makes errors in capitalization, punctuation, spelling and/or grammar, and the writing is exceptionally easy to read 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Writer uses some words that communicate clearly, but the writing lacks variety, punch or flair - Writer makes some errors in capitalization, punctuation, spelling and/or grammar 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Writer uses a limited vocabulary that does not communicate strongly or capture the reader's interest. - Writer makes many errors in capitalization, punctuation, spelling and/or grammar, and this greatly interferes with the flow of the piece
Voice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The writer seems to be writing from knowledge or experience of knowing this person. The author has taken the ideas and made them "their own" - Quotes and references are used when appropriate to enhance the narrative 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The writer relates some of their own knowledge or experience of this person, but there is no strong ownership of the topic - Quotes and references are used sparingly and are not integrated smoothly into the narrative 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The writer has not tried to transform the information in a personal way. The ideas and the way they are expressed seem to belong to someone else - Quotes and references are sparse and/or awkwardly introduced into text
Creativity/Presentation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Pictures, videos, maps and graphics enhance the narrative and are visually appealing - Format, layout, text and organization looks professional 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - There are either too many or too few visuals scattered about the document - Format, layout, text and organization feels like an amateur project. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Few if any visuals are present in the document or the visuals interfere with the narrative in awkward ways. - Format, layout, text and organization feels sloppy and rushed.
